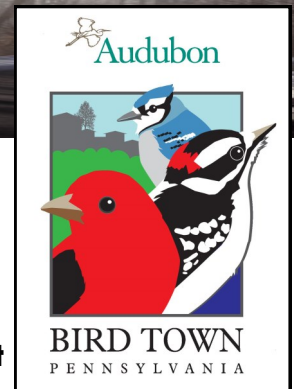
The **Great Backyard Bird Count** is Here!

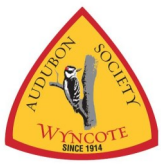
